

3. 本處初步接納申請後，申請人須接受一般性健康檢查，所需費用由申請人自行支付。
4. 完成上述手續及簽署一切有關文件後，本處將盡快為申請人安排服務。
5. 服務使用者或其家人、監護人如欲終止服務，可向本處社工及轉介社工提出退出服務要求，以便作出安排。本處亦可基於不同情況，例如兒童不再符合接受服務資格、兒童或其家人的行為對提供服務的人士構成危險等，要求兒童退出服務。

服務費用

寄養服務為服務使用者提供免費住宿及膳食服務，其他開支須依據協議由兒童家人／監護人支付。社會福利署會透過本機構向寄養父母發放兒童的生活津貼。

寄養服務

機構簡介



香港青少年服務處為社會福利署資助的多元化社會服務機構，服務範圍包括臨床心理服務、綜合家庭服務、兒童之家、寄養服務、綜合家居照顧服務、地區青少年外展社會工作服務、深宵外展服務、綜合青少年服務中心、青少年中心、課餘託管及學校社會工作。

服務範圍

寄養服務的宗旨是為極需援助的兒童提供暫時性的家庭照顧，直至他們可以與家人團聚或被安排接受較長期的照顧，服務的主要目標如下：

1. 依據個別兒童福利計劃，安排兒童入住寄養家庭，使其能夠在一個安全和穩定的家庭環境得到照顧，並作定期檢討。
2. 保障和促進寄養兒童的健康和福祉，並照顧他們的整體成長和發展，包括身心、社交、情緒與智能發展的需要；
3. 鼓勵寄養兒童發展潛能，以及培養責任感、自尊心和自我照顧的能力。

服務對象

接受寄養服務的兒童，年齡由初生至未滿十八歲及得不到家適當照顧的兒童。他們大部份是健康及正常的孩子。另外，亦為有特別需要兒童（例如輕微殘疾、輕度智障或健康欠佳等）提供照顧。

服務內容及形式

寄養服務是兒童暫時接受寄養家庭照顧的服務，同時亦會有一名社工為兒童提供輔導及指導服務，確保孩子身心得到照顧，寄養服務所提供的服務包括：

1. 為兒童選配合適的寄養家庭
2. 提供督導及支援予寄養家庭
3. 提供定期探訪予兒童，輔導及跟進服務使用者的福利計劃
4. 跟進兒童在離開寄養家庭後的狀況



服務時間

本處轄下的寄養服務提供全日24小時照顧。

申請及退出手續

1. 有意申請寄養服務者，可向社會福利署或志願機構之綜合家庭服務中心、保護家庭及兒童服務課、醫院醫務社工、學校社工、外展社工、綜合青少年服務中心社工、教統局或志願機構轄下的心理學家、輔導員或學生輔導主任查詢。
2. 所有申請須經由社會福利署中央寄養服務課統籌。本會收到轉介申請後，將透過轉介社工約見申請人及其家長或監護人。



3. General medical check-up is necessary after the application is accepted in principle. Applicants are liable for all relevant charges.
4. Service will be rendered as soon as possible upon the completion of the above mentioned procedures and signing of papers.
5. Withdrawal request can be raised by service users and their families / guardians to our social worker or referral worker for further arrangement. The Agency maintains the right to terminate the service under different circumstances. For example, the child no longer meets the service requirements or the child / their parents / guardians' behaviour cause danger or have undesirable influence to the service providers.

Fees and Charges

Foster care services are free of charge. Other charges should be paid by children's families / guardians according to the agreement made. Foster Care Allowances will be given to foster parents by the Social Welfare Department via our Agency.

Foster Care Service

Introduction



Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency subvented by the Social Welfare Department. The Agency provides social services including Clinical Psychological Service, Integrated Family Service, Small Group Homes, Foster Care Service, Integrated Home Care Services, District Youth Outreaching Social Work Service, Overnight Outreaching Service, Integrated Children and Youth Services Centres, Children and Youth Centre, After-School Care Service and School Social Work Service.

Purposes and Objectives of Service

The aim of Foster Care Service is to provide temporary care for children in foster families until they can return to their families or a long term alternative welfare plan is achieved. The objectives of Foster Care Service are:

1. To provide substitute care for children in a stable and safe family living environment for a limited period of time, as specified by the individual welfare plan and subject to review on a regular basis.
2. To protect and promote the health and welfare of children and nurture their overall growth and development, including their physical, social, emotional and intellectual needs.
3. To encourage the development of potential, responsibility, self-esteem and self-care amongst children in care.

Target Group of Service

The target group is children aged from newborn and under 18 years of age who cannot be adequately cared for by their families. Most children are healthy and normal. Besides, service and care would be provided for those children with special needs (for example, mild physical handicaps, mild mental handicaps or minor health problems).

Scope of Service

The children are cared by foster families supported by the social worker who provides advice and guidance for them regarding the care and well-being of the children. The services of Foster Care are as follows:

1. To choose and match suitable foster families for the children.
2. To provide supervision and support to foster families.
3. To provide regular visit and counseling for the children and carry out their welfare plans.
4. To provide follow-up and support services for the children when they leave foster families.



Operation Hour

Foster Care Service provides round-the-clock care service.

Procedures of Application and Withdrawal

1. Application can be directed to the Integrated Family Services Centre of the Social Welfare Department or other non-government organizations, Family & Child Protective Services Unit, medical social worker, school social worker, outreaching social worker, social worker of Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre, psychologist, counsellor and student counselling officer of the Education and Manpower Bureau Department or other non-government organizations.
2. Referrals are via the Central Foster Care Unit of the Social Welfare Department. Interview will be arranged for applicants and their parents/guardians through the referral workers upon the receipt of referrals.
