機構簡介

香港青少年服務處為多元化社會服務機構，服務包括綜合家庭服務、臨床心理服務、綜合家居照顧服務、兒童之家、寄養服務、綜合青少年服務中心、課餘託管、青少年中心、學校社會工作服務、地區青少年外展社會工作服務、深宵外展服務及濫用精神藥物者輔導中心。

服務宗旨及目標

中心服務旨在培育青少年成為愉快、成熟、具責任感及對社會有貢獻的市民，從而達致下列目標：

1. 培養青少年的個人成長，協助他們了解自我、掌握情緒、培養處理困難的能力及充分發展個人潛能。
2. 增進青少年的社會發展，促進與家人及朋輩間的人際關係，鼓勵他們積極參與及貢獻社會。

服務對象

中心服務對象為服務區域範圍內三至三十歲的兒童、青少年及其家庭。

服務範圍

按地區特色和需要，透過中心服務，以個人輔導、小組及社區活動之社會工作方法，籌劃和推行下列四項核心服務：

1. 指導及輔導服務
2. 為處於不利環境的青少年提供支援服務
3. 培育青少年自我發揮、個人成長及建立和諧人際關係的小組及活動
4. 培養青少年關心及參與社會的小組及活動

中心亦會透過不同類型的活動，例如：康樂活動、興趣班與小組、自修室及閱讀室設施等，輔助上述服務的推行。

開放時間

星期二、四及五	下午二時至六時 晚上七時至十時
星期六	上午十時至下午一時 下午二時至六時 晚上七時至十時
星期三及日	下午二時至六時

申請及退出手續

1. 服務使用者可親臨中心，或以電話或書面方式，向中心申請服務。
2. 凡年齡由三至三十歲的青少年均可申請成為中心會員。
3. 凡子女年齡介乎零至三十歲之家長均可申請成為家長會員。
4. 單親家庭人士、綜援家庭人士、來港居住不足三年之新抵港人士及經社工轉介之人士均獲豁免會員年費。
5. 服務使用者如因各種原因退出服務或活動，可向負責工作人員提出，中心會按個別情況處理。

服務費用

中心每年四月調整會員年費，活動費用按個別情況而定。單親家庭人士、綜援家庭人士、來港居住不足三年之新抵港人士及經社工轉介之人士均可獲豁免會員年費及可申請活動費用減免。（減費金額需視乎個別活動而定）

• Introduction •

Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency. The Agency provides social services including Integrated Family Services, Clinical Psychological Service, Integrated Home Care Services, Small Group Homes, Foster Care Service, Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre, After-School Care Service, Children and Youth Centre, School Social Work Service, District Youth Outreaching Social Work Service, Overnight Outreaching Service and Counselling Centre for Psychotropic Substances Abusers.

• Purpose and Objectives of Service •

The aim of Service is to assist children and young people to become happy, mature, responsible and contributing members of society. The specific objectives of centre are:

1. To facilitate well-balanced personal development of children and young people, helping them to develop life skills, potential and problem solving ability.
2. To facilitate the social development of children and young people, enhancing family and other interpersonal relationships and developing contribution to, and participation in, the community.

• Target Group of Service •

Centre provides service to children and young people between the ages of 3 and 30 in service district and their families.

• Scope of Service •

By means of center service, the following four core services are provided through case work approach, group and community activities according to community needs.

1. Guidance and counselling
2. Supportive services for children and young people in disadvantaged circumstances.
3. Socialization programmes aimed at fostering individual development and harmonious inter-personal relationship.
4. Social responsibility enhancement programmes aimed at enhancing civic mindedness and involvement in community affairs.

Varieties of supportive programmes including recreational activities, interest classes/groups, study/reading room facilities are also provided.

• Opening Hour •

Tuesday, Thursday and Friday: 2-6p.m., 7-10p.m.
Saturday : 10a.m.-1p.m., 2-6p.m., 7-10p.m.
Wednesday and Sunday: 2-6p.m.

• Procedures of Application and Withdrawal •

1. Enrollment can be made in person to centre. Phone and postal application will also be accepted.
2. Children and young people between the ages of 3 and 30 are eligible for centre member.
3. Parents of children and young people aged 0 to 30 are eligible for parent membership.
4. Single-parent families, CSSA recipients, new arrivals for staying in Hong Kong less than 3 years or clients referral by social workers can apply for remission of membership fee.
5. Service users can make a request to the responsible worker if he/she intends to withdraw from our services or activities. The request will be handled on an individual basis.

• Charges of Service •

Membership charges is subject to annual adjustment in April. Programme fees vary in accordance with the nature of the activity. Single-parent families, CSSA recipients, new arrivals staying in Hong Kong for less than 3 years and by referral from social workers can apply remission for membership and programme charges which are vary in accordance with the nature of
